



Using TurboStats Ultra with StatBroadcast Broadcastr

You will need an active license to TurboStats Ultra or higher in order to proceed (the lower versions do not offer Webcasting) and you will need TurboStats installed on your computer and a game already created in it, ready to score.

You will also need to have the StatBroadcast Broadcastr downloaded and installed on your computer (that can be found at <http://software.statbroadcast.com>)

Open your game in TurboStats

Press the Live Score button to open the live scoring view

Click on the Settings (Gear) Icon



In most instances, you can leave the default folder in place at C:\FOOTBALL\

If you do need to change the folder location where the file is saved, click on the folder name to open the browser. In the browser window, locate your new save folder and click 'Open'.



Click the 'Post' button to bring up the WebCast menu. Then click on 'WebCast'.



The Local XML Webcast window will launch. **IMPORTANT: DO NOT CLOSE THIS WINDOW.**


Please leave it open in the background or minimize it for the duration of the game.


The blue text shows to the path to your XML file. **You will need this for Broadcastr in the next steps.**





Launch Broadcastr.

When prompted, select Yes to load new event and then enter your login info.












Choose your event from the list and select Load Configuration









You'll now need to tell Broadcastr where to find the XML file.



Use the XML file path from the Webcast screen in TurboStats (the dark blue text)




Select the folder (by default, that is the C: drive and FOOTBALL) and double-click it to open. Then select the turbostats.xml file.


Press Open once the file is selected.







Click the green Start Transmitting button



If successful, you will see a green checkmark and the time of the last file sent.

You must leave both Broadcastr and the TurboStats Webcast window open for the duration of your game to continue sending updates.
